President's Report

- Gail D'Amico has been participating in several committees and meetings to promote Friends of Ortley Beach including Toms River Cultural Arts Project, the Green Team, Grunin Foundation Catapult Your Capacity, TR Chamber of Commerce Nonprofit Committee & Applaud Our Kids.
- The Green Team is developing a community garden at Riverwood Park. Gail will partner with Fulfill on a Community Garden initiative starting in April. Plots for sale are \$15/season and consist of a 4x6 foot raised bed in a locked fence located at Riverwood Park in TR (off of Whitesville Road/ 14 minutes away). Any Ortley Beach resident can rent one—Contact Gail. FOB will help promote the garden.
- Gail and/or Julie & Jodi have attended, or will attend, several professional development seminars to help further our mission & goals.
- Gail applied for a \$5000 Good Neighbor grant on behalf of FOB from OceanFirst Bank to help fund a community bulletin board on Ortley's boardwalk. We should hear if we got the grant in about 2 months.

- Jodi McCaffrey provided an update on FOB's social media metrics
 - It was suggested that FOB pursue other methods of communication for those not on social media or without a computer. Suggestions included an email newsletter, a print newsletter, and/or a mailing to homes
- New Speaker Series FOB is developing a speaker series that will feature local speakers talking about topics relevant to Ortley Beach. Vote was taken & the series will be held the first Thursday of the month at 6:30 p.m. beginning on May 2. Dennis volunteered St. Elisabeth's Chapel. Speaker series details will be posted on Facebook and emailed to members.
- Tracking volunteer hours Gail explained that all FOB volunteers and board members should track the hours that they spend carrying out FOB business for grant purposes as in-kind hours. A print form has been developed and will be distributed at future meetings and will be posted on FOB's website. Jodi McCaffrey will collect and tabulate forms each month. - We are moving forward with Give Lively, a new fundraising vendor for our website. The system will streamline online giving, paying membership dues, and other fundraising activities. Pete Conrad is spearheading this effort.
