- Membership and Social Media: Jodi McCaffrey said that we have just under 140 members and provided an update on FOB's social media metrics: We have 1,320 followers on Facebook, 618 on Instagram and 79 on Twitter.
- The 3rd annual Kites, Crafts & Cones Festival will be held 7/27 at the 3rd Avenue Boardwalk. Julie is working with TR police department to direct traffic, rope off sections of the parking lot, etc. Julie, Gail, and Jodi have been soliciting sponsors and raffle prizes. Paul Jeffrey suggested asking for smaller gift card amounts and grouping them together.
- The TR Shakespeare Festival will present Measure for Measure 8/7 at St. Elisabeth's Chapel at 7 p.m.
- Doggie Day on Ortley Beach will be held 8/24 in the 3rd Avenue parking lot. Paul reported that 18 vendors have committed for the event and sponsors include Pampered Pets, VCA, and ShopRite. This year's event will include a variety of contests (shortage legs, longest ears, etc.) to encourage public participation.
- Gail is speaking at the 7/16 meeting of the TR Green Team.
- Toms River Maker fest 10/12/2019 We will again present a STEAM project at Toms River Makerfest. Ideas are welcomed, and we'll need volunteers to man the table and work with kids on the project.
